Gan ddilyn llwyddiant gŵyl 2005 a ganolbwyntiai fwy ar hanes, bydd gweithgareddau eleni yn cyflwyno i chi'r digwyddiadau diweddaraf yn America Ladin ac yn archwilio materion cyfoes pwysig megis y newid hinsawdd a thegwch byd-eang. Rydym ni hefyd wedi ehangu'r rhaglen, gan roi mwy fyth o gerddoriaeth, dawns, barddoniaeth a theatr i chi o America Ladin, Cymru a gweddill y byd.

Yr ysbrydoliaeth y tu ôl i El Sueño Existe ydy Victor Jara, y cyfarwyddwr theatr, y canwr, y cyfansoddwr a'r gweithredwr gwleidyddol enwog o Chile. Chwaraeodd ran amlwg mewn sefydlu'r mudiad 'Cân Newydd' Chileaidd ond cafodd ei boenydio a'i ladd yn ystod y chwyldro yn Chile ym 1973. Mae'r gwrthgyferbyniad rhwng themâu ei ganeuon, am gariad, heddwch a chyfiawnder cymdeithasol a'r ffordd gïaidd y cafodd ei lofruddio wedi trawsnewid Jara yn symbol parhaol o ymdrech dros hawliau dynol a chyfiawnder ar draws America Ladin.

The Dream Lives on

Welcome to El Sueño Existe – a unique event which brings Latin American music, politics and culture to the beautiful Welsh countryside.

Drawing on the success of the 2005 festival which took a historical perspective, this year's activities bring us right up to date with recent developments in Latin America and explore important contemporary issues such as climate change and global equity. We've extended the programme too, bringing you even more music, dance, poetry and theatre from Latin America, Wales and the rest of the world.

El Sueño Existe takes its inspiration from Victor Jara, the renowned Chilean theatre director, singer-songwriter and political activist, who played a pivotal role in establishing the Chilean 'New Song' movement and was tortured and killed during the 1973 Chilean coup. The contrast between the themes of his songs, on love, peace and social justice and the brutal way in which he was murdered transformed Jara into an enduring symbol of struggle for human rights and justice across Latin America.

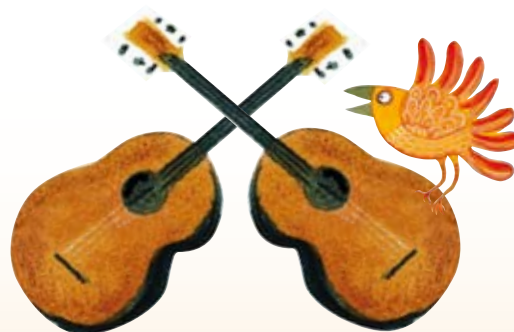
